

## LENT 2026

| <b>FEBRUARY 18</b><br>Ash Wednesday   | <b>Ash Wednesday</b> begins the Lenten season. <b>The imposition of ashes</b> will take place at 09:00 at the Eucharist and between 17:00 and 18:00 via the “drive by” method we started during the Covid pandemic. |
| <b>MARCH 29</b><br>Palm Sunday        | High Mass and distribution of palm crosses.   |
| <b>MARCH 29</b><br>Start of Holy Week | <b>Holy Week</b> commemorates Christ's triumphal entry into Jerusalem.  |
| <b>APRIL 2</b><br>Maundy Thursday     | <b>Maundy Thursday</b> Evening Eucharist of the Lord's Supper. 18:00. We celebrate Mass according to the Book of Common Prayer.   |
| <b>APRIL 3</b><br>Good Friday         | <b>Holy Week</b> climaxes with the Passion of Jesus. Service from 12 noon.  |
| <b>APRIL 5</b><br>Easter Sunday       | <b>Easter Sunday</b> always occurs on the first Sunday after the Paschal Full Moon, which is the first Sunday following the full Moon that occurs on or after the Spring Equinox.                                   |

### LENT 2026

In the New Testament, the phrase *the mind of Christ* appears in 1 Corinthians 2:16 and Philippians 2:5-8. It refers to the perspective, purpose, and plan of Christ, which believers share:

*Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others.*

<sup>5</sup> *Have this mind among yourselves, which is yours in Christ Jesus,*

<sup>6</sup> *who, though he was in the form of God, did not count equality with God a thing to be grasped,*

<sup>7</sup> *but emptied himself, by taking the form of a servant, being born in the likeness of men.*

<sup>8</sup> *And being found in human form, he humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.*

Lent begins on Wednesday, February 18 (Ash Wednesday) It is a 40-day period of prayer, fasting, and reflection leading up to Easter Sunday, which falls on April 5.

We will offer the imposition of ashes on Ash Wednesday at 09:00 in the context of Holy Communion and again between 17:00 and 18:00 in drive-by mode.

Father Klaus will conduct the morning service and Deacon Chris the evening service.
